## NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Sealed bids will be accepted by the Oceana County Road Commission, 3501 W. Polk Road, Hart, Michigan 49420 no later than 2:00 PM on Thursday, May 24, 2018, after which time they will be publicly opened and ready aloud in the Board Room for the following:

### **Garfield Road Overlay and Wedging from 132<sup>nd</sup> Avenue to 154<sup>th</sup> Avenue (Garfield Road is the dividing line between Ferry and Otto Townships)**

Overlay will consist of approximately 3,600 feet of 13A HMA, with approximately 80 lbs. per square yard skim coat, and a top course of approximately 160 lbs. per square yard. More base may be necessary to level certain areas. Wedging will consist of spot wedging either individual lanes or full road width for approximately 3,200 feet of 13A HMA, at approximately 160 lbs. per square yard. When paving is complete, pavement markings shall be restored. The overlay and wedging is to be a minimum width of lane or both lanes as specified on drawings and/or as directed by engineer or representative. The pavement will be marked for the contractor before the job start or as agreed upon.

Contractor will be responsible for traffic control which is estimated to include flagging operations during paving, and cones during paint striping. Traffic control shall be performed according to Part 6 of the MMUTCD and the MDOT Michigan Traffic Regulator Manual.

All materials and labor are to conform to MDOT 2012 Standard Specifications for Construction, or the most current MDOT standards.

### **All work shall be completed by June 30, 2018.**

**Bid specifications are available at the Hart Road Commission office. All bids are to be in sealed envelopes and plainly marked "Garfield Road Overlay and Wedging" with the name of the bidder.**

The Road Commission reserves the right to reject any and all bids or to waive irregularities therein, and to accept any bids which, in the opinion of the Road Commission, may be most advantageous and in the best interest of the County.

## INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS

Refer to the INVITATION TO BID for the exact timing and for the identification of the bid as related to furnishing materials, services, equipment, work and/or supplies with the terms, conditions, specifications, drawings, plans, and special provisions as stated herein and hereto attached.

The Road Commission's normal practice is to have the bids opened and read, then referred to Staff for tabulation and analysis. During this period, the files are closed until this action is complete. Generally, this may involve three or four days depending upon the nature of the bid. Copies of the bid tabulations are made available only after this time and upon request to the Clerk, by mail or phone (231) 873-4226.

1. All bids must be submitted on the Road Commission's bid blank form when provided. The bid shall be legibly prepared in ink or typewriter. Erasures or alterations must be initialed by the bidder. The bidder must acknowledge all addendums. The bid shall be mailed or delivered. Separate bids shall be in a sealed envelope and identified on the outside as to the specific category concerned. Bids will not be accepted beyond the designated time limit set for the acceptance of the bids. The bidder shall assume full responsibility for late delivery or non-delivery regardless of the manner he/she employs for the transmission thereof. Bids will be accepted in the office on behalf of the Road Commission during normal business hours, legal holidays excepted. Specifications and/or plans should not be returned with bid unless otherwise stated herein.
2. The OCRC, in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 78 Stat. 252, 42 USC 2000d to 2000d-4 and Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Federally-assisted programs of the Department of Transportation issued pursuant to such Act, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of gender, disability, race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award.
3. It is understood the Oceana County Road Commission is a governmental unit and as such exempt from the payment of all State and Federal taxes, except as allowed by the regulatory agencies to be included in the cost of materials and services.
4. The bidder, by execution of the bid proposal, thereby declares that the bid is made without collusion with any other person, firm, or cooperation, and agrees to furnish all bid items in strict accordance with all Federal regulatory measures.
5. **For the Bid Categories designated as "NEW", detailed contracts shall be signed by the selected bidder. If that bidder does not agree to the contract then the award shall be to the next qualified bidder.** The Road Commission reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive any irregularities therein, and to accept any bid which, in the opinion of the Road Commission, may be most advantageous and to the best interest of the County. In case of error in the extension of prices in the bid or other arithmetic error, the unit prices will govern.
6. All materials and services, unless otherwise stated, shall meet the latest Michigan Department of Transportation's Standard Specifications for Construction.
7. **All materials, unless otherwise stated, are to be F.O.B. Hart – (3501 Polk Ave., Hart, MI.) and/or M20 – (100 W. M20 Shelby, MI.).**
8. Any modification from the requested terms shall be noted, and initialed on the supplied bid form(s), and a description of the modification shall be included.
