Jordan Smith, CPA, with our auditing firm Maner-Costerisan, provided an overview on our 2023 Act 51 Financial Statements. He reported our fund balance increased \$3,848,397 and that the Net position increased \$3,404,067 during 2023. OPEB is 114% funded. The result of the audit was a clean unmodified opinion which means that the company's financial statements are presented fairly and comply with generally accepted accounting principles (GAAP). This is the highest rating possible.

RESOLUTION NO. 1 - JURISDICTIONAL TRANSFER OF ~460 FEET OF S. LAKESHORE DRIVE (FRANCIS STREET)

STAFF REPORTS

Chairman Myer welcomed Commissioner Gowell back.

Mark Timmer reports that the State crew has been patching various routes, storm cleanup, shoulder and drainage maintenance and mowing US 31.

The M-20 and the Hart crew has patched various roads with the hot box, Chip sealed and Fog sealed. Traffic Services supervised sign crew/County Work/State Work, worked on asset management, Miss Digs, Road Soft, sign repairs, street name signs, permits, closures and detours for road work and bridge jobs.

Mark Timmer reviewed bills and finances with the Clerk, contractor working on Roosevelt Bridge, Rieth Riley paved Meadow Lane at Lake Tahoe, paved base on 126th, paved base and top on Shelby Rd in Ferry, Madison Road is open, York and Polk thin overlays are done for Road Bond, 116th in Elbridge is crushed, Rieth Riley is paving base today, Hallack is crushing 176th. Montcalm County Road Commission brought entire chip seal crew to help us. We ran two entire chip seal crews and a fog seal crew this week. Chip Sealing will be done today. We just have to finish fog sealing. Hallack Crush and Shape 126th.

At the next meeting, September 25, 2024, we will review Lakeview Drive at School Section Lake in Colfax. Lakeview is a real narrow road and in some spots it's only 9 feet wide.
