## STAFF REPORTS

The State crew did tree cleanup from the storm, and has been placing mastic with Kent County Road Commission on Polk Road.

The M-20 and Hart crews patched various roads with the hot box, put slag on Roosevelt Road in Claybanks Township, started gravel on Wren Road in Benona Township, shouldered Ridge Road, graded and repaired gravel roads, and tree cleanup from the storm.

Traffic Services has worked on asset management, Miss Digs, Road Soft, permits, sign repairs, street name signs, supervised the sign crew, marked roads for paint, both long line and special markings, and installed school zone signs for the Village of Shelby / Shelby Schools (on Oceana Drive).

Mark Timmer reviewed bills and finances with the Clerk and Finance/HR Director, Roosevelt Road Bridge and road are finished and open, Ridge Road is finished and open, and Michigan Pavement Markings (MPM) is finishing long line striping and working on special markings.

Mark Timmer showed his appreciation and such a privilege to manage a facility with such a great staff, employees and Board Members.

Chairman Myers asked if there was any further business to come before the Board. There being none, the Meeting was adjourned at 10:24 AM.
