STAFF REPORTS

Managing Director reports that the State crew, M-20 garage crew and Hart garage crew have been mowing.

Hart garage and M-20 garage crew patched with hot box, graded gravels for brine and repair, performed slag upgrades on 54th and McKinley Road in Grant, 48th, 56th Ave in Benona, Pike Road in Shelby township.

Brine update – Newfield, Shelby, Benona, Hart, Pentwater, Golden, Otto, Ferry, Elbridge, Leavitt, Greenwood and Claybanks townships were brined as of June 8th, 2026. Crystal, Grant, Colfax townships were scheduled to be brined the week of June 15th, 2026 and later.

Engineering supervised tunnel electrical and final closeout, worked on township estimates, started Longbridge Fisherman’s Platform project, worked on Polk Road design and 2026 Mill and Fill/rehab.

Finance/HR worked on payroll and payables.

Traffic Services/Safety worked on asset management, sign repairs, RoadSoft, and permits, supervised sign crew/county work, completed stop sign/stop ahead upgrade countywide. Traffic Services/Safety worked on brine maps.

Managing Director reviewed bills and finances with Assistant Managing Director-CFO and Accountant.

Managing Director attended MDOT Maintenance Budget meeting; received numerous signed road work estimates from townships.

Staff prepared for Open House scheduled for Thursday, June 11th, 2026 between 11am-3pm.
