State

Repaired Box Culvert on M-120 South of Arthur Road for MDOT. Plan to pave crossing today and re-install guardrail and open for traffic potentially Thursday or Friday.

M20 and Hart Garages

Patched various roads, graded gravel roads, repairing roads, mowed in county North Townships, brushing with loader brush attachment in Newfield Township, working on timber sales roads for Forest Service (168th Avenue and Tanner Swamp), durapatched 56th Avenue South of Webster Road in Claybanks Township, Baseline Road in Ferry Township, and did slag upgrade on Baker Road for the Conservation District.

Engineering

Had meetings and plan review for M20 Tunnel and OCRC and MDOT reviewed 75% plans. Tunnel is ordered from Contech. Contractor started Sign Upgrade (Safety Grant). Worked on project closeout paperwork for Madison Road. Coordinated subcontractors and detour for M-120 Culvert repair and detour.

Full time Truck Driver/Road Worker began work, we are interviewing for an Administrative Assistant, our Director of Finance/HR Lori Holmes announced her retirement effective October 31, 2025.

Traffic Services/Safety

Supervised Sign Crew/County Work/State Work, worked on asset management, sign repairs, Road Soft, and permits, long line paint striping and special markings. Designed closure/detour for M-120. OCRC was presented three Statewide Safety Awards from CRASIF, our workman's comp/liability pool. A Goose Egg award for zero time off injuries, an Honor Roll award for having an experience modification factor below 1.00, and an Experience Modification Factor Award for having the lowest mod factor in the State in our class (.648). These awards are a great reflection on staff and bargaining unit employees and their commitment to working safely on a daily basis and their buy in to safety training and using the correct equipment and PPE.

Reviewed bills and finances with Assistant Manager-Clerk and Finance Director. Madison Road is finished. I attended the CRA Commissioner's Conference at Bay City and did a PowerPoint Presentation on Road Bonding, then attended the CRASIF Annual Conference and business meeting at same location.
